

SCOPE OF SUPPLY

1. Tenders are invited through Government e- Marketing Place (GeM Portal) in Single Stage Two Cover bidding procedure [Technical Bid and Financial Bid] for the Supply of 4 coils of 220 M each **48mm Polypropylene Rope** for using at Grab Hopper Dredger - Nehru Shatabdi of Cochin Port Authority, Willingdon Island, Kochi, Kerala as per specification and conditions given below:

2. **Specification:**

Material – Polypropylene

Diameter – 48 mm

Construction – 8 - Strands

Quantity Required- 4 coils of 220 M - each.

Certification. - Manufacture's Test Certificate

Conditions:

1. Detailed Technical Specification/Brochure of the offered product should be uploaded along with the bid document.
2. Offers not as per the specifications contained in the Specification Document will be left out of consideration.
3. Bidder should mention the **Make/ Brand** Name of the quoted Polypropylene Rope, offers without mentioning the quoted brand/make will be left out of consideration.
4. The bidder should not submit their offer with any **conditions / counter conditions** anywhere in the tender document. The conditional tenders, if any, shall be considered as non-responsive and shall be summarily rejected.
5. Bidder should upload signed and sealed GeM Bid Document and Specifications and Conditions Document along with the bid as a token of acceptance of specifications and conditions of the bid.
6. Polypropylene Rope should be supplied in Roll of 220 Mtrs. at the Divisional stores, Ernakulam Wharf, Cochin Port Authority, Willingdon Island, Cochin- 682009, Kerala State Ph: 0484 2582468/74.
7. Guarantee: Quoted Polypropylene Rope should be guaranteed for -- 12 Months from the date of receipt of material at site.
8. Guarantee Certificate should be submitted along with the material/ invoice.
9. Manufacture's Test Certificate should be submitted along with the supply.
10. Payment terms: 100% payment shall be made only after satisfactory Supply and acceptance of the Polypropylene Rope at site to the entire satisfaction of the Engineer in charge.
11. Marine Engineering Superintendent, Cochin Port Authority shall be the Engineer in charge for this procurement
12. Terms of delivery: F.O.R at Site, Divisional stores, Cochin Port Authority, Willingdon Island, Cochin- 682009, Kerala State.
13. Delivery period: **30 Days** from the date of Purchase Order.
14. Consignee: Asst. Engineer (M), Materials Management Division, Cochin Port Authority, Willingdon Island, Cochin- 682009, Kerala State, Contact No: 0484 2582468/70/71/74.
15. Invoice should be addressed to: Sr. Dy. Materials Manager, Cochin Port Authority, Willingdon Island, Cochin- 682009, Kerala State.

16. To assist in the examination, evaluation and comparison of bids, Cochin Port Authority may ask bidders, individually for clarification of their bid. The request for clarification and the response shall be sent through GeM Portal, but no change in price or substance of the bid shall be sought, offered or permitted.
17. **Income Tax Deduction:** Deduction of Income Tax shall be made from any amount payable to the Contractor as per the relevant provisions of the Income Tax Act.
18. **TDS under GST Law:** Tax shall be deducted under GST law as per prevailing rate.
19. **Evaluation and comparison of bids:** Only such bids, as determined to be substantially responsive to the requirements of the bid documents will be evaluated. Other non- responsive bids will be rejected. The Port's decision on this shall be final, conclusive and binding.
20. **Acceptance of Tender:** Cochin Port Authority does not bind itself to accept the lowest tender or any tender and reserves the right to accept any tender in part or to reject any tender or all tenders without assigning any reasons whatsoever.
21. The supplier shall ensure the coverage of Transit insurance while raising the RR/LR etc.
22. Unloading of the items at site shall be arranged by Cochin Port Authority. No additional payment other than the quoted rates shall be paid.
23. **Settlement of Dispute & Arbitration:** In the event of any dispute or differences arising out of this contract, it is hereby agreed to settle the dispute amicably by mutual discussions/ negotiations. In the event of failure of mutual discussions/ negotiations the parties shall jointly appoint a sole arbitrator to resolve the dispute as per the provisions of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996.
